New Zealand Sampler Gathering 2021 CLASSES

The cost of the Saturday class is included in your registration fee of \$190. Please indicate your class preference on the registration form with payment for your first option. The requirements list for your class, with instructions for any pre-class preparation will then be sent to you. Finishing options will be discussed in class.



Trish Hill will teach a small Table Accessory Set embroidered on 32 Count Permin fabric – colour of your choice. A partial kit will be supplied, including pincushion stuffing, jar for pins and needles, cotton reel and patterns at the cost of \$20.

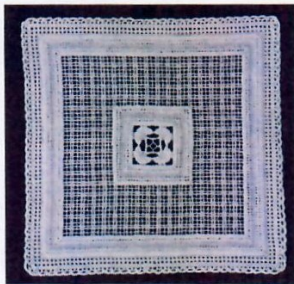
Note: A small amount of preparation will be required.

The workshop is suitable for embroiderers of all levels of skill.



Jenny Hunter is teaching China Blue, a Counted thread technique, using the outline of a bowl. Students will fill the shape with horizontal rows of surface stitchery to create shape and dimension. The top part of the design is worked in cross stitch using single strands of silk and cotton floss. Counted threadwork size: 7 ¾" X 9 ½". All threads and fabric will be provided in a kitset at a cost of \$35

This workshop is suitable for embroiderers of intermediate level up.



Kerry Seeley is offering a Drawn Thread class for more confident stitchers. "Get Drawn in" with a Lace Edge. This is stitched on 28 count linen with Perle 8 and 12 threads.

Note: There will be some tacking and stitching required before class.

This workshop is suitable for advanced stitchers.



Jill Wilson is teaching a 5 cm cube with 6 faces, with the choice of 2 designs. The Christmas cube has an Assis Xmas tree, a blackwork bauble, a snowflake and the 3 other faces are stitched with cross stitch, darning stitch, and Wessex. The other option is a whitework cube, which can also be stitched in colour. The 6 faces are stitched with cross stitch, darning stitch, satin stitch, canvas stitch, pulled thread and the last face a variety of stitches.

Note: Participants will be required to do the backstitching of the 6 faces prior to the weekend.

This workshop is suitable for embroiderers of all levels of skills.
